

The Farmington Players Barn Theatre COVID-19 Mitigation Plan

The Farmington Players will follow reasonable and responsible protocols to ensure the safety of patrons and members. Federal, state, and Oakland County health agencies may mandate mitigation protocols at any time as public health experts. The Farmington Players will communicate and comply with all mandates if and when they occur.

The Farmington Players will follow standard mitigation measures regardless of transmission level.

- **Cast & Crew Vaccine Policy:** In accordance with The Farmington Players 2021-2022 vaccine policy, all members of the cast and crew (including volunteers) must be fully vaccinated from COVID-19 to participate our productions.
- **Cleaning Practices:** We have increased the amount of professional cleaning during the run of our shows.
- **Hand-Sanitizing:** We have free-standing hand sanitizer stations throughout the building.
- **Illness Management:** Individuals who are sick should stay home and seek medical advice and testing.
- **Concessions:** We will only have bottled water for a donation for our patron's safety.
- **50/50 Raffle Protocols:** We will minimize contact by selling at a station.
